

About the Residency

The primary goal of the QFC-UW PGY-1 Community Pharmacy Practice Residency Program is to foster the formal postgraduate education and training for pharmacists in community pharmacy and internal medicine setting. The objectives of the 12-month residency program are to:

- Advance the Pharmacy Resident's knowledge in drug therapy, medication and disease management, as well as health screenings and wellness education
- Develop communication and management skills to deliver patient-focused care and implement new innovations in service delivery.

This program represents the collaboration between QFC Pharmacy and the University of Washington School of Pharmacy. It is one of the newest additions to the University of Washington School of Pharmacy Community and Ambulatory PGY-1 Residency Program, accredited by the American Society of Health Systems Pharmacists and its partner organization the American Pharmacists Association since 2004.
