



# FELLOWSHIP STRUCTURE

## YEAR ONE: UNIVERSITY OF WASHINGTON (MS)

- Gain principles and methods of HEOR through rigorous courses in biostatistics, epidemiology, economic evaluation, and outcomes research
- Complete MS thesis (real-world data analysis)
- Present congress posters and/or publish manuscripts
- MS degree in HEOR awarded upon completion

## YEAR TWO: INDUSTRY

- Demonstrate product value utilizing strategically-focused HEOR
- Understand role of HEOR in drug development and commercialization
- Collaborate cross-functionally
  - Medical affairs/communication
  - Market access/brand strategy
  - Regulatory affairs
  - Clinical development
- Manage external vendors

### **OVERVIEW**

- > Eligibility: Degree in Pharmacy by July 1, 2024
  - Must hold U.S. citizenship or permanent residency status to apply
- > **Application Deadline:** October 23, 2023
- > Interview Notification: October 30, 2023
- > Virtual Interviews: Week of November 6, 2023
- > Offer Notification: Rolling, after interviews
  - Decisions requested by December 13, 2023
- > **Program Start Date:** July 1, 2024



#### **APPLICATION & INTERVIEW TIPS**

- > Contact your recommenders early
  - Include a "cheat sheet" about yourself, the program, and why you are applying to the program along with your recommendation request
- > Submit a strong, <u>focused</u>, <u>and well-edited CV</u>
  - Research skills
  - Data analysis skills
  - Relevant rotations, electives, courses, and presentations
  - Leadership experience
- > Highlight any projects relevant to HEOR
- > Don't forget thank you emails
- > Relax! Be calm, be yourself!





### **Application Fee Waiver Information**

- > Financial Need Fee Waivers are available through the Graduate School
- > Fee waiver requests must be submitted <u>at least 7 days</u> before the deadline
- > <u>Washington State Need Grant Program</u> eligibility criteria is used to determine financial need.
  - Waivers are based on the 100% Median Family Income (MFI).
  - Reported income should be based on the most recent tax year.
