In 2020, faculty members from all three School of Pharmacy departments – Pharmaceutics, Medicinal Chemistry and Pharmacy – produced a total of **470** peer-reviewed publications (an average of 8 per faculty member). Together, the three departments also host a total of **17** elected fellows of national academies or professional societies.



## A CUTTING-EDGE CURRICULUM

Introduced in 2019, the **Purple Curriculum** makes the UW School of Pharmacy one of the few programs nationwide offering experiential training from the start of student pharmacists' first year. Through the program, students work directly with patients – learning to interview, gather information, consider patients' holistic needs, and gain critical continuity in their learning. This novel approach to training prepares our student pharmacists to step into new, dynamic, accessible and impactful pharmacy practices.
